Irene Alice McGee, died peacefully in her home on Thursday, December 28, 2017, at the age of 97.

Irene Alice Cummings was born September 23, 1920, in Elma, Iowa to Francis Emmett and Mary Evelyn (Harris) Cummings. She grew up on the family farm and attended country school with her four sisters and six brothers. She met the love of her life, Bernard J. McGee, at a dance in Cresco, Iowa. Rene corresponded with Bernard during the years he was enlisted in the U.S. Navy during WWII, while she was working at a munitions factory in California and later at a company in Waterloo, Iowa. Bernard and Rene were married on May 6, 1947 in Cresco, Iowa and moved to Austin, Minnesota where Bernard pursued a career in carpentry and Rene worked at the Canton Café.

In June of 1948 they welcomed their first born, James M. McGee and a short year later their daughter, Susan in May of 1949 and soon to follow, Ann, in December of 1951 and Mary, in December of 1952.

Rene was a member of St. Augustine Catholic Church. Along with the Canton Café, she also worked at the Austin Bowl. Rene was a member of the "Sewing Club" along with several friends and neighbors.
